**Confession of Faith** Psalm 22:1-19

My God, my God, why have You forsaken me? Why are You so far from saving me, from the words of my groaning?

**O my God, I cry by day, but You do not answer, and by night, but I find no rest.**

Yet You are holy, enthroned on the praises of Israel.

**In You our fathers trusted; they trusted, and You delivered them.**

To You they cried and were rescued; in You they trusted and were not put to shame.

**But I am a worm and not a man, scorned by mankind and despised by the people.**

All who see me mock me; they make mouths at me; they wag their heads;

**"He trusts in the LORD; let Him deliver him; let Him rescue him, for He delights in him!"**

I can count all my bones – they stare and gloat over me; they divide my garments among them, and for my clothing they cast lots.

**But You, O LORD, do not be far off! O You my help, come quickly to my aid!**
