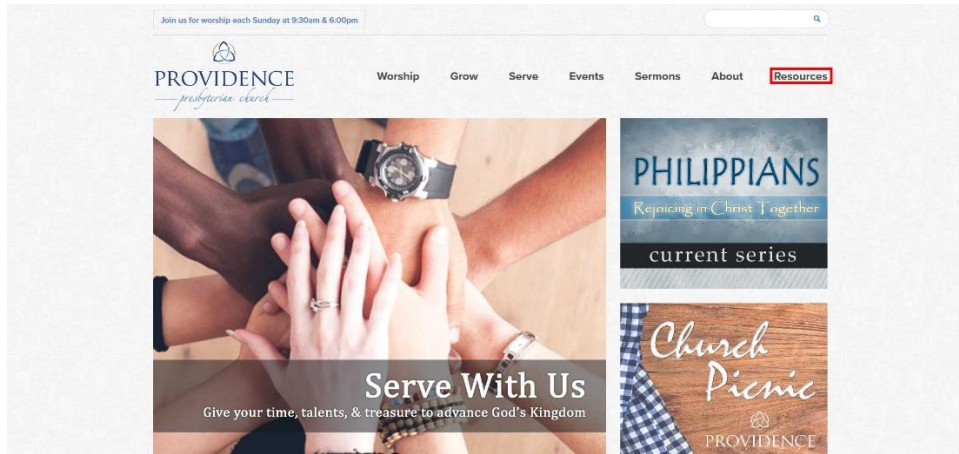


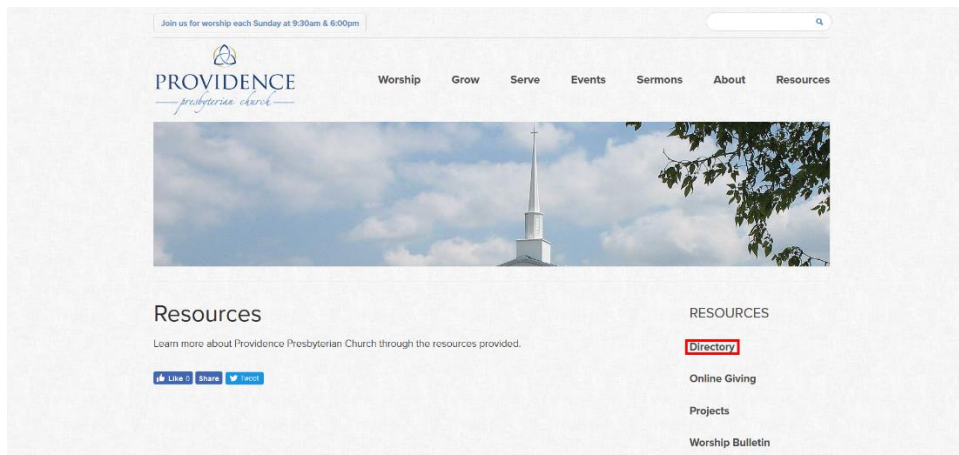
Two ways to get to PPC's OneBody Directory...

Go to <https://www.providencesalisbury.org>

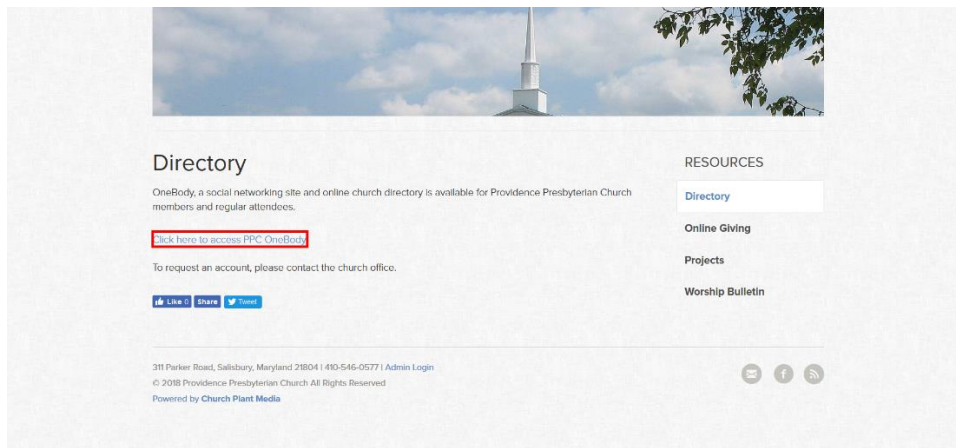
Click "Resources"...



...then click "Directory" ...

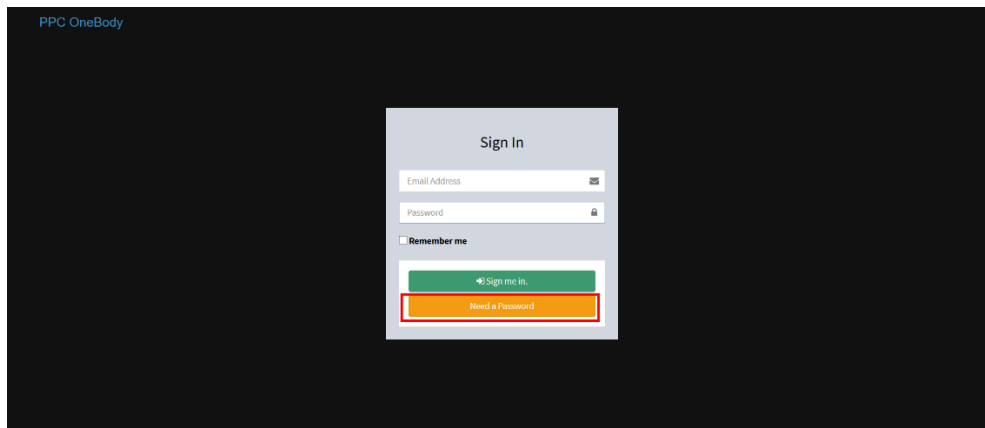


...then click on the link "Click here to access PPC OneBody"

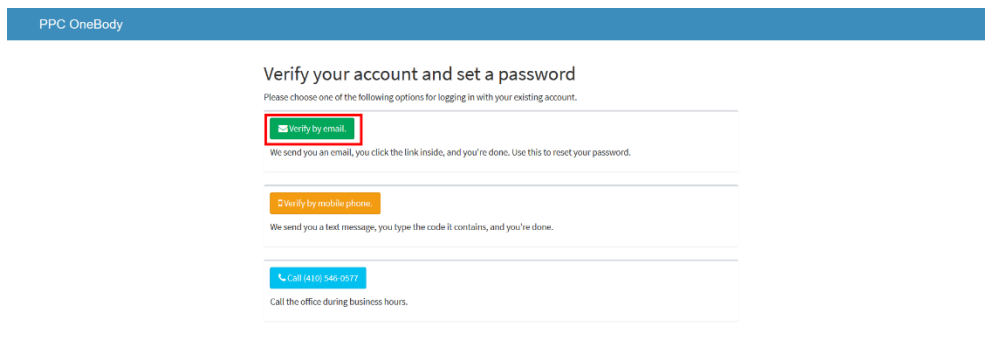


Or, go directly to <http://onebody.providencesalisbury.org>

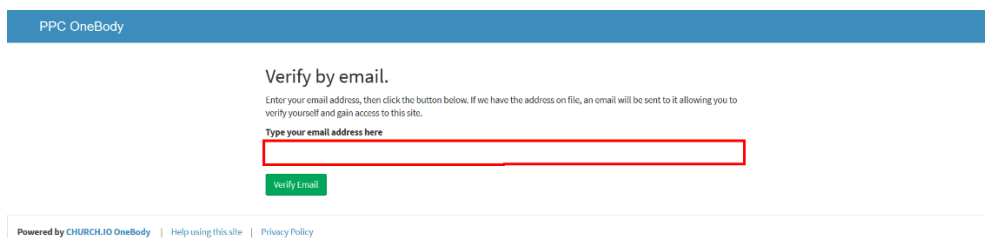
Click on “Need a Password” button.

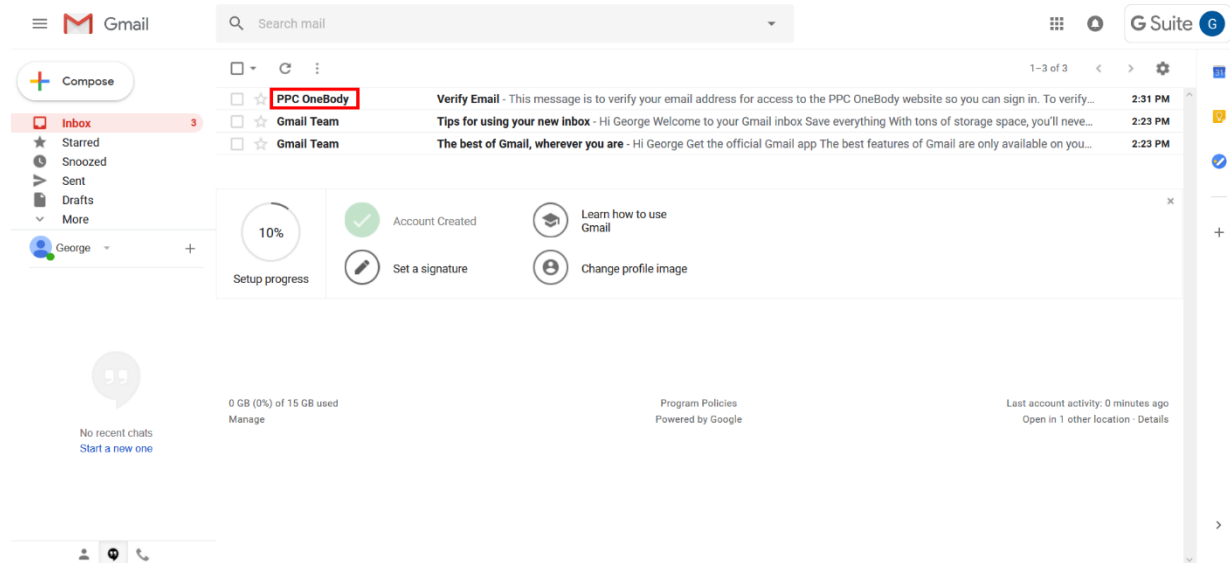
You should then see this screen:

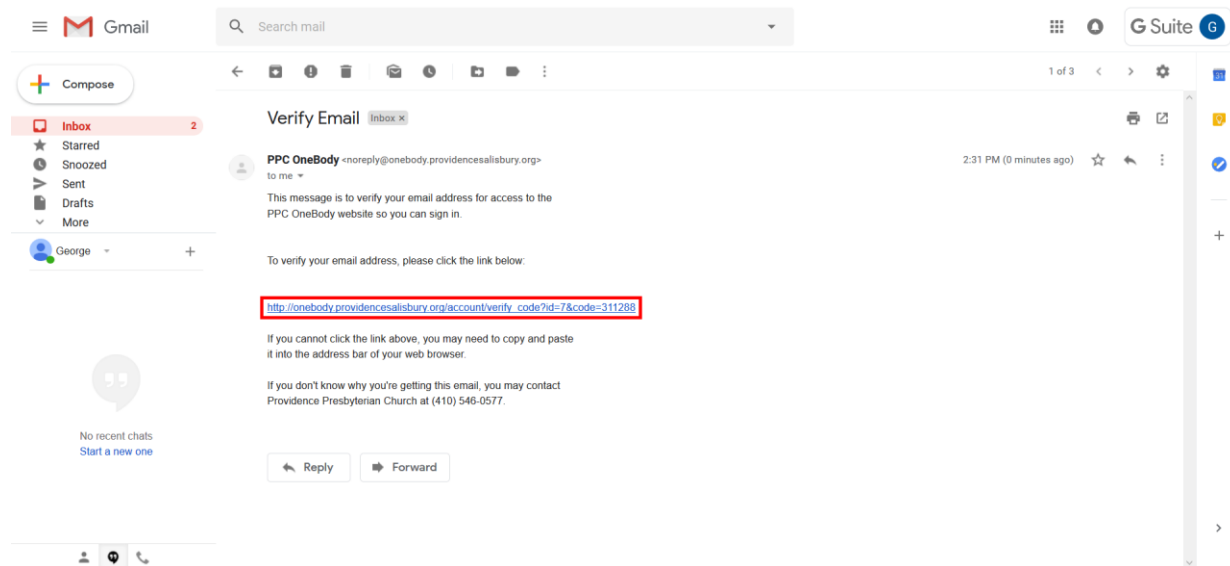
A verification email has been sent to you. Please check your email and follow the instructions in the message you receive. (You may have to wait a minute or two for the email to arrive.)

Click on the link in the email to verify your identity. This will take you to your profile page on the PPC OneBody site.



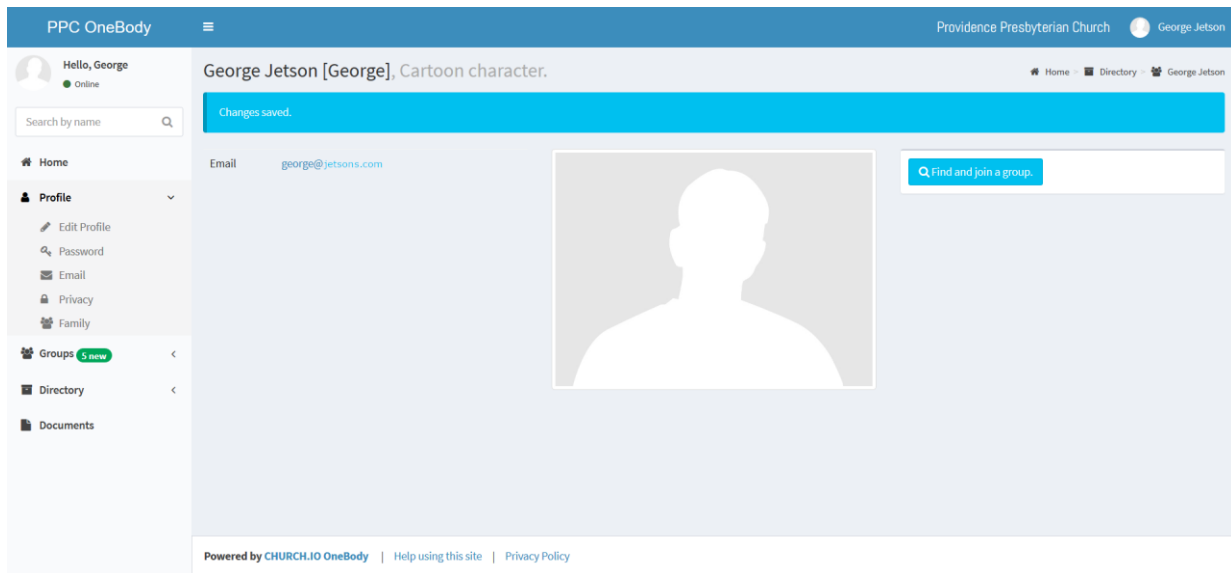
Enter your email address, and then create a password by typing it in the appropriate boxes. You'll have to type it twice, and it will not show up as you type.
