Vision: What do we envision accomplishing with this proposal?





We seek to empower our REACH partners both financially and with personal involvement in changing lives.

1. Develop an annual Community Volunteer Fair - to mobilize our members and the community around Red Clay in Compassionate Service with identified REACH Partners.
 - a. We envision this to be a fun event for the whole family that could include the following:
 - i. Activities for the kids perhaps in partnership with the Scouting program and church education ministries.
 - ii. Food drive
 - iii. Live music
 - iv. Food trucks or food booths that support key partners.
 - v. Workshops by REACH partners highlighting their work and opportunities for volunteers
 - vi. Opportunity to promote mission partners in Costa Rica & South Africa
2. Possibly use this Community Volunteer Fair to award Lawton Fund grants and to celebrate the investments that Red Clay Creek makes in the Wilmington area.
3. Collaborate with other area churches around adult educational lectures & workshops and cultural programs in music and the arts. Collaborate around mission trips for youth & adults.

What will be the impact of this proposal?

1. The fair will be a celebration of meeting the needs of diverse populations.
2. Also an opportunity to educate Red Clay Creek Church & Community members on the work of these non-profit partners and the opportunities to volunteer for compassionate service.
3. This highlights a core value of Red Clay Creek
4. Provide greater collaboration among area churches.
