Discussion Questions for Luke 11:37-54

- As a group, try to remember some of the general points and illustrations of the sermon.
- 1. Carlos said that a hypocrite is the Greek word for an actor. One who plays someone else. He said that religion breeds hypocrisy.
 - a. How do we see that in this passage?
 - b. How can the present day Christian community hypocritical? How are we?
 - c. Why do we focus so much on the outside of the dish?
- 2. Carlos said that we have to be rescued from hypocrisy. Grace is what can transform hypocrisy into love.
 - a. Jesus has the most compassion for the most broken. They don't think they are good enough. Why is this?
 - b. How do we let Jesus heal us from the inside out?
 - i. We have to recognize first that we are the outsiders who need God's mercy.
 - c. "In the cross I see myself for who I really am and I see Christ for who He really is." Discuss
- 3. Is there integrity between who I am on the outside and who I am on the inside? What is a way we can tell? V42 gives a clue
 - a. Does it matter that we are right if we don't have mercy and justice?
 - b. The grace filled heart has the ability to love and live from the inside out.
 - c. When you compare your outside to your inside where do you need more of the Gospel?
 - d. Compassion means 'with suffering'. For whom do you feel compassion? Is your Christianity reaching beyond your church and yourself?
