Luke 12:1-12

Do your best to recall the various point of the sermon

The main point of the sermon was: *Jesus has demonstrated to us, he is worthy of all of our hearts devotion. Don't settle for anything less than giving all of yourself to all of him.*

1. Jesus said , *“Beware of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy.”*
  1. What is the hypocrisy Jesus is talking about?
  2. What will be the result of their hypocrisy (vs. 3)
  3. God is calling us to whole-hearted devotion. How do we do this?
2. Whole-hearted devotion leads to whole-hearted trust. Why are we not to fear those who can kill in this life?
  1. God calls us to fear him and then tells us not to fear him. How do we do both of these things simultaneously?
  2. Jesus numbers every hair on our head. What does this show you about God?
  3. When do you find it hard for you to trust God?
3. See Luke 12:8-12. Do you ever worry about what you would do in this situation?
  1. Where can we find confidence from this scripture?
  2. What do we learn about the Holy Spirit in this passage?
