

EDiBS Bible Study Participants Guide #3: John 15:5 – 27

March 26 – John 15:5-8

1. Three times in this section of Scripture, Jesus talks to His disciples about “remaining” in Him. Why would it be so important for them to remain in Him? (v.5)
2. How do we remain in Christ? (v.7)

March 27 – John 15:9-17

1. Jesus said that true love for Him expresses itself in what kind of attitude? (v.9,14)
2. What comfort does it bring to know that Jesus has “appointed” us to bear fruit? (v.16) How does that teaching fly in the face of those who believe that we live by chance?

March 30 – John 15:18-22

1. Why would the world hate the disciples, and why does the world hate believers today? (v.19)

March 31 -- Dealing with the Coronavirus

1. What did Pastor Stark say would be the most powerful way you will be ministered to in this time of great distress?
2. What two verses did Pastor Stark recommend we meditate on to keep our faith strong?

April 1st – John 15:23-27

1. Jesus said, “He who hates Me hates My Father.” (v.23) The Jewish leaders claimed they didn’t need to believe in Jesus to be saved; they believed in the ‘God of Abraham.’ How do Jesus’ words contradict that?
2. When the world hates us, we will be tempted to respond by changing the Gospel message. Instead, what help did Jesus say He would bring for His followers? (v.27)
