Suffering - A Path to Hope

Romans 5:3-5 "... but we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, and hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us."

This passage is one of my favorites because it starts with suffering, something that's been an integral part of my own story as well as the lives of the men and women and parents I meet with; and while the journey starts with suffering, it ends with hope.

Because of what Jesus did for us on the cross and God's love for us, we endure through times of suffering and trials. We persevere and continue to pursue holiness in the face of our unwanted LGBTQ desires, we continue to hold to Biblical truth while loving and praying for our LGBTQ loved ones, and we continue to stand on God's truth regarding LGBTQ behavior when we find ourselves at odds with our culture. It's in these times

as we focus our eyes on Him that we encounter God's faithfulness as He walks with us, we find His love and grace sufficient for us in our circumstances, we develop spiritual resilience - the ability to increasingly follow God's will for us and stand firm on what we know to be true, and we develop Godly character as we are refined more and more into the image of Christ.

And character produces hope. The hope we find, and the joy we encounter, is in knowing that in the midst of the suffering and trials, that God poured out His love on us, that He was faithful and never left us, and that our suffering has had a purpose – to transform us more into the character of Christ. I know this has been true of my life. It has been through seeking him and his love for me during times of suffering that my love for Him as grown the most, that my spiritual resilience has been strengthened, and that I've grown more in His image. I pray it will be the same for you.

Looking Back at 2020 and Ahead at 2021

Last year was quite unusual when a disease that harmed many Chinese citizens emerged and swept across the globe. Sars CoV-2 invaded our daily lives: masks, toilet paper

shortage, social distancing, cancelled events and family gatherings were all impacted. Some lost loved ones to the pandemic. Our HOPE Conference and pastor Equip Events became consolidated into one big online event--HOPE 2.0--which had the largest attendance with people from four continents. We were delighted to share 17 full scholarships to HOPE. *Thank you to all of you who donated to our scholarship fund!*

I gave radio interviews throughout 2020: Janet Parshall's "In The Market", Eric Metaxas Show TBN-NY, Julie Roys, as well as local Christian radio. Online articles published in Focus on the Family's Daily Citizen, The Stream, Lifesite News, Christian News Journal, Christian Post, Christian News Now, and my testimony taped for CBN's 700 Club. I spoke at a number of online conferences including--teen apologetics, adult worldview conference, connected with believers in Eastern Europe, and advised a few large Christian ministries on LGBT topics.

Other highlights in 2020, we welcomed two new member ministries to our network--Exchange Ministries (FL) and The Way Out Ministries (OH). A new affiliate category was created--Spiritual Mentor--with hopes of drawing in younger leaders. Various plans emerged for better equipping pastors, including an effort alongside Legacy Institute (WA).

Another highlight was hiring KaSaundra as my assistant. Married to a wonderful man of God and raising their two delightful teen girls, KaSaundra joined us from AIMS and had been executive assistant to Dr. Howard Foltz. She has since led the charge on member renewals, video uploads, document revisions, my calendar management, and more. I am grateful to the Lord for KaSaundra.

2021 News

New Member

2021 brought RHN another new member ministry, Vital Signs of Northern Michigan (parents group) is led by Chuck and Denise Bowman who have tender hearts for families grappling with LGBT identities.

Networking and Challenges

2021 brought challenges from the new political climate and federally proposed 'Equality Act', which would seek to punish any who differ from the secular culture's beliefs about gender and sexuality. In private leader meetings, I have been addressing how to handle 'cancel culture' in some practical ways.



RHN continues to meet with many international, national, and statewide strategic and legal groups. Networking opportunities have broadened.
