

## 4.3.16 Primer

Colossians 3:17-19

### Hear the Good News:

*Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. “Honor your father and mother” (this is the first commandment with a promise), “that it may go well with you and that you may live long in the land.” Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord. (Ephesians 6:1-4 ESV)*

*Children, obey your parents in everything, for this pleases the Lord. Fathers, do not provoke your children, lest they become discouraged. (Colossians 3:20-21 ESV)*

### The Point:

Raise your kids well, yes, but, ultimately, just keep pointing them to Jesus. He is the only one who can effectively change them - just like he's the only one who can effectively change you.
