

# 12.08.19 Primer, John 11:45-57

**On Sunday Pastor Christian talked about how every single person regardless whether they believe or don't believe- all have a response to Jesus. Nobody is neutral. What we saw is how the Pharisees & Sadducees make a decision about Jesus, not based on who he is, but based on how he would affect their life. How do you respond to who Jesus is? **Ask the Lord to guide you as you journal your thoughts on the following questions:**

1. Caiaphas, the Pharisees & Sadducees had total disregard for who Jesus was. This was due to fear and how Jesus might mess up their own plans. Is there an area where you have not surrendered because you are worried how it may affect your life?
2. Where in your life are you putting your desires above God's desires?
3. God is not just a God of love. He is also a God of holiness and justice. How do you view him? Do you lean one way more than the other?
4. There is no neutrality while being a follower of Jesus (Revelation 3:16). He is either our King, or He is not. We either love and worship or Him or we don't. Are you hot or cold? How would your family & friends describe your walk with Jesus?
