HEAR THE GOOD NEWS: 1 Peter 2:4-10

THE POINT: The church is God's people filled with God's presence to accomplish God's purposes.

EMBRACE THE GOOD NEWS:

1) What does this passage teach about God? (His commands, his expectations, his characteristics, his desires)

2) What does this passage teach about man in his natural, unspiritual state?3) What does this passage teach about God's expectations for followers of Jesus?

4) With what we've discussed, try to summarize the passage in your own words as if you were explaining it to a friend.

LIVE THE GOOD NEWS:

1) What does this passage mean for disciples who make disciples?

2) What does it mean for leaders who make more leaders?

3) How does this passage impact the way that you live out the Good News in your home and in your relationships with friends and family?

a) Parents: How can you model these truths to your kids and help them to understand these complex concepts?

4) How does it impact the way that you weave the thread of the gospel as you interact with your church family? In our local community? To the ends of the earth?

5) Come up with 1-3 "I will" statements in response to this passage that address the way you view God or the way that you live your life.

Based on 1 Peter 2:9, consider sharing what God is doing in your life in 2016 by writing a brief testimony using the materials provided on the back counter and placing it in the jar hanging on the back wall.
