John 10:1-21

Theme: To every Christian, Jesus says, *“I intimately know you, died and rose for you, called you by name, and will lead you to heaven.”* What a Savior!

- 1) Jesus Is The Good Shepherd (10:1-6)
 - a) In contrast to faithless shepherds (1-2)

 - b) Who calls his sheep by name and they follow him (3-5)

 - c) Response of the Jews: confusion (6)

- 2) The Good Shepherd Lays Down His Life For The Sheep (10:7-21)
 - a) Jesus is the only way to be saved (7-9)

 - b) Jesus came to save (10)

 - c) Jesus accomplishes our salvation by dying and rising again (11-18)
 - i) The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep (11-15)

 - ii) The good shepherd is going to save a multiethnic people (16)

 - iii) The good shepherd will rise from the dead (17-18)

 - d) Response of the Jews: division (19-21)
