Isaiah 42:1–4

Main point: Jesus was broken and extinguished to heal you of your bruised and darkened heart.

I. You are bruised up and burnt out

II. He is going to use you as you are

III. Jesus was broken and extinguished for you

Conclusion:

Questions to consider: Are you aware of how bruised and faintly burning you really are? What self-protective measures do you employ to fight this? When do you rest in Jesus for his healing and strength?
