Shown and Grown

Mark 4:21–34

Main Point: The kingdom of God is way different than what you would ever expect. The way it is shown and grown is what you really need.

I. Jesus is the light that reveals the kingdom of God.

II. The kingdom of God grows according to God's design.

III. God's design for his kingdom is unexpected greatness.

Conclusion:

Questions to consider: Jesus is the light of the world that brings life. Does his light shine brightly in your life, exposing sin, assuring of pardon? Is his light bringing growth in your life and the lives of those around you?
