Now all I know is grace

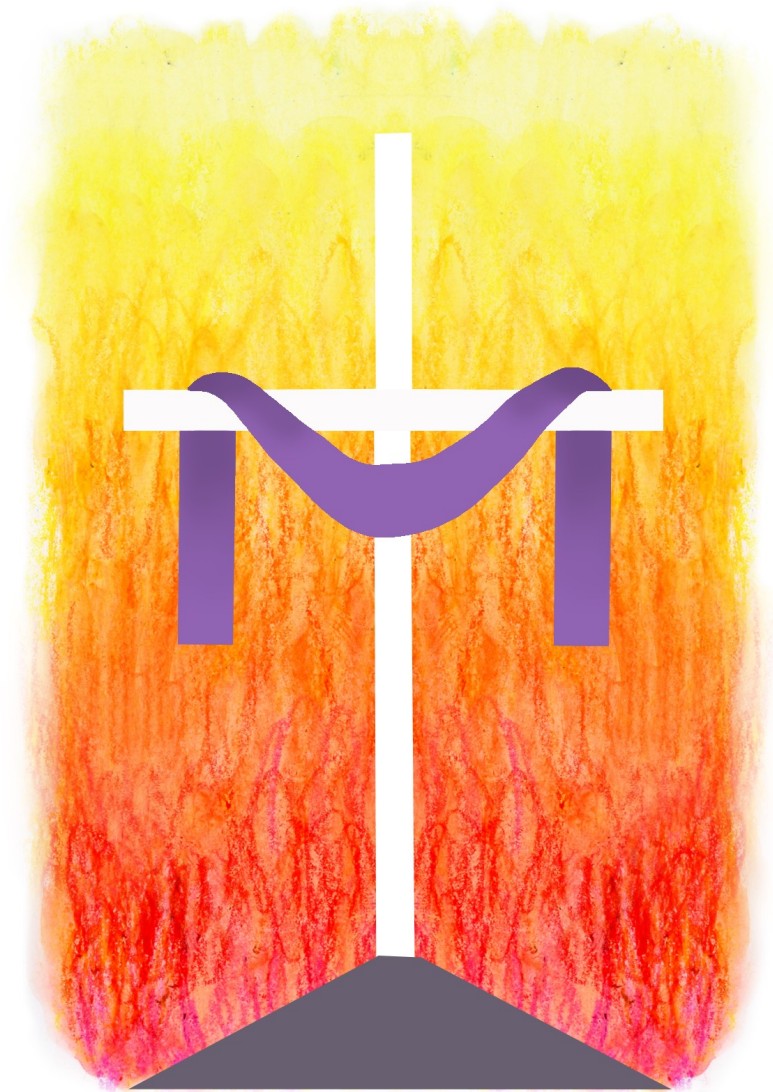
