Isaiah 59:1–21

Main point: No matter how far your sins have flung you, God's arm can catch you and bring you close.

I. You are far flung from God because of your sin

II. Your sin carries dire consequences

III. God's grace extends to great lengths

Conclusion:

Questions to consider: Are you aware of your sin and how it has separated you from God and from others? Have you found the fountain of God's grace as he has delivered you from your sin?
