- Confession of Faith Westminster Larger Catechism, Q. 77

Leader: Why do you believe that Jesus Christ is your Lord?

All: Although sanctification is inseparably joined to justification, the two are distinctly different. In justification God imputes the righteousness of Christ to believers; in sanctification his Spirit infuses believers with grace and enables them to use it. In the former, sin is pardoned; in the latter, it is subdued. The one exempts all believers equally and completely from the avenging anger and condemnation of God in this life; the other does not work equally in all believers, nor is it completed in any believer in this life, but only grows toward perfection.
