Leader: The LORD is my strength and my shield; in him my heart trusts, and I am helped; my heart exults, and with my song I give thanks to him.

All: In your Son is our salvation, in your promises our hope. We thank you that we are your children and that you enliven us with the Spirit of the Son, and in the end receive us into your glory, through Jesus Christ our only Savior. Amen.
