### ■ Confession of Faith Westminster Shorter Catechism Q&A 45–47

Q 45: Which is the first commandment?

A 45: The first commandment is, "Thou shalt have no other gods before me"

Q 46: What is required in the first commandment?

A46: The first commandment requires us to know and acknowledge God to be the only true God, and our God; and to worship and glorify him accordingly.

Q 47: What is forbidden in the first commandment?

A 47: The first commandment forbids the denying, or not worshipping and glorifying the true God as God, and our God; and the giving of that worship and glory to any other, which is due to him alone.
