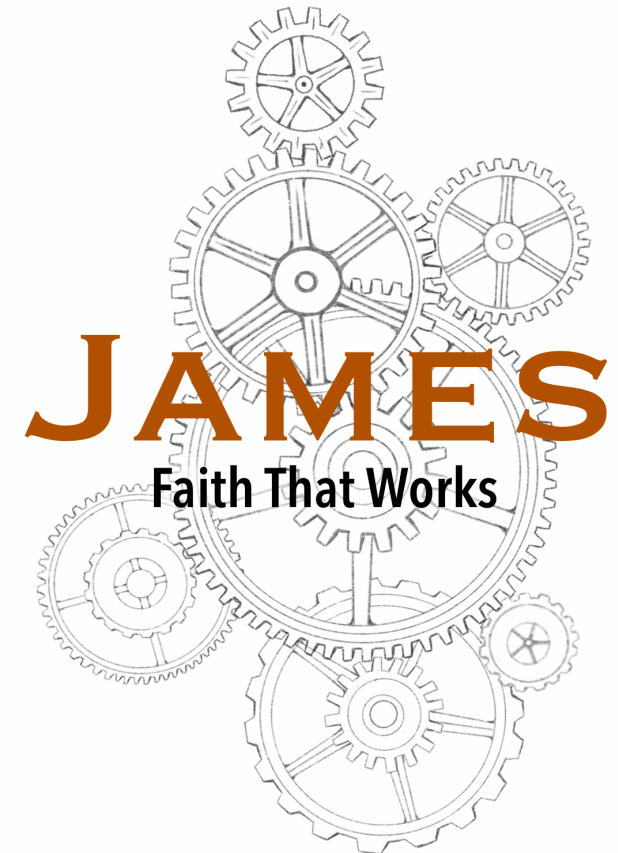

I. Yikes!

II. 4 reasons "the rich" will get it in the end.

- A. Trust in the provision rather than the provider
- B. The Lord hears the cries of injustice
- C. Luxury at other's expense
- D. Disposable "obstacles"
