Q. 36      What benefits in this life accompany or flow from justification, adoption and sanctification? A. 36      The benefits in this life which accompany or flow from justification, adoption and sanctification are: assurance of God's love, peace of conscience, joy in the Holy Spirit, progress in holiness, and perseverance in it to this life's end.	
Q. 37      What benefits do believers receive from Christ at death? A. 37      The souls of believers are at their death made perfect in holiness and immediately pass into glory; and their bodies, being still united to Christ, rest in their graves until the resurrection.	
Q. 38      What benefits do believers receive from Christ at the resurrection? A. 38      At the resurrection Christ will immediately raise up in glory all believers; he will openly acknowledge and acquit them in the day of judgement, graciously rewarding them according to their works of faith, and they will enter into the full enjoyment of God for all eternity.
