Confession of Faith/Heidelberg Cat. #12-15 Pastor Mark Lauterbach

Q12. According to God's righteous judgment we deserve punishment both now and in eternity: how then can we escape this punishment and return to God's favor?

A12. God requires that his justice be satisfied. Therefore the claims of this justice must be paid in full, either by ourselves or by another.

Q13. Can we make this payment ourselves?
