Confession of Faith/WSC Q&A #88, 98-99

Q88. What are the outward and ordinary means by which Christ gives to us the benefits of redemption?

A88. The outward and ordinary means by which Christ gives to us the benefits of redemption are his ordinances, especially the word, sacraments, and prayer, and all these are made effective in the salvation of the elect.

Q98. What is prayer?

A98. Prayer is an offering up of our desires to God, for things agreeable to his will, in the name of Christ, with confession of our sins and thankful acknowledgement of his mercies.

Q99. What rule has God given for our direction in prayer?

A99. The whole Word of God is of use to direct us in prayer, but the special rule of direction is that form of prayer which Christ taught his disciples, commonly called the Lord's Prayer.
