- Q88. What are the outward and ordinary means by which Christ gives to us the benefits of redemption?
- A88. The outward and ordinary means by which Christ gives to us the benefits of redemption are his ordinances, especially the word, sacraments, and prayer, and all these are made effective in the salvation of the elect.
- Q91. How do the sacraments become effective means of salvation?
- A91. The sacraments become effective means of salvation not because of any power in them or in him who administers them, but only by the blessing of Christ and the working of his Spirit in those who receive them in faith.
- Q92. What is a sacrament?
