## Confession of Sin/4<sup>th</sup> Commandment

Confession of Faith/WSC Q&A #58, 60

Q58. What does the fourth commandment require?

A58. The fourth commandment requires us to set apart to God the times He has established in His word - specifically one whole day out of every seven as a holy Sabbath to Him.

Q60. How do we keep the Sabbath holy?

A60. We keep the Sabbath holy by resting the whole day from worldly affairs or recreations, even ones that are lawful on other days. Except for necessary works or acts of mercy we should spend all our time publicly and privately worshiping God.
