Here in the love of Christ I stand.

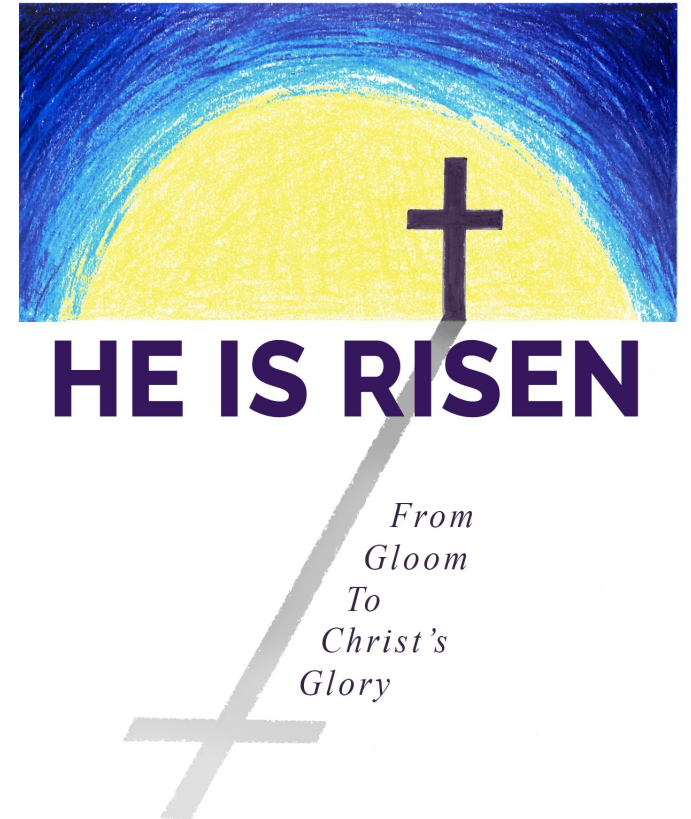
In Christ alone, who took on flesh,
