This program provides an extra hour after school on Tuesdays for 2, 3 & 4 year olds to have play time. The children are supervised by two teachers. The cost is \$6 per day, with semester rates available.

Our Mission

The weekday preschool program operates as an evangelical ministry of Rivermont Evangelical Presbyterian Church, providing a Christcentered ministry of love and caring to families and young children within the church family and the community. The Rivermont Preschool offers a program of age-appropriate, developmental activities to nurture children's spiritual, social, academic, and physical development in an atmosphere of Christian love, caring, and acceptance. The Rivermont Preschool seeks to establish a partnership in education with families to help ensure that the preschool years form a good foundation in these areas of development. The goal is to encourage and develop a positive self-image and to help the child experience the love of Jesus.

Curriculum

Our curriculum includes an age-appropriate developmental centers approach; meaning that an environment in each classroom is created around various centers of play (play is a child's work). These centers include Blocks, Dramatic



Play, Toys and
Games, Art, Library,
Discovery, Music and
Movement, Cooking,
and Outdoors.
Each day's schedule
includes play at these
centers, circle time
activities, lunch, and
Bible story time. This
curriculum operates
within the framework
of a monthly theme
and scripture. For

example, our theme for September is "All About Me" and the scripture is "I am wonderfully made" **Psalm 139:14**. During Bible story time, we teach Bible stories using various approaches such as books, music, and "role-playing."

Staff

Our Christian teachers hold an education degree or have training and experience in working with young children. We place a strong emphasis on staff training and development to further equip our teachers with skills to make your child's early learning experiences the best possible. Our preschool program operates under the direction and supervision of the Preschool Council, and the day to day operations under the direction of the Director of Children's Ministries.



Facilities

In compliance with the Code of Virginia, our Preschool is a religious exempt childcare facility operated and sponsored by Rivermont EPC and regulated by the Virginia Dept. of Education meeting all required health and safety requirements. The preschool is fully insured.

Our facilities include four classrooms with restrooms, a room for indoor games, and a fellowship hall for special events. We also have use of the church playground for outside time. Our enrollment capacity is for 48 children.

Program Information

The 2022-2023 school operates
Monday thru Wednesday, 9:00 am to Noon.
Children bring their own snacks/lunches.
Parents are welcome to provide Birthday treats.

Our Classes include:

One Year: One YO by Sept. 30th.

Meets one day.

Two Years: Two YO by Sept. 30th.

One and Two day options.

Three Years: Three YO by Sept. 30th.

Meets two days.

Pre-K: Four YO by Sept. 30th.

Meets three days.

Our program runs from August to May. In early August, parents of registered children will receive a Preschool calendar and welcome letter from the Preschool Director.

We hold special events for our families throughout the year. These include: Nature programs, Christmas play, Community Helpers month, Grandparents' Day, Noah's Ark Parade, and End of Year Celebration/Pre-K graduation.
