

Sermon Discussion Questions: Luke 19:28-40

1. What in the sermon encouraged you, comforted you, challenged you, or informed you?
2. In what sense does our nostalgia and memories of our past accomplishments and joys leave us discouraged about losses? What losses most discourage you?
3. How does Jesus' title as the Alpha and the Omega, who was, and is, and is to come (Revelation 1:8) and his title as the first and the last describe His control over all things? See Isaiah 46:8-11. How might this encourage you in specific situations you are facing now that are out of your control?
4. Jesus, the Living One, died and is alive forevermore (Revelation 1:18). How does his death and resurrection accomplish a victory over death altogether for those who trust in Jesus? See 1 Corinthians 15:22-26.
5. How does the certainty that Jesus has the keys to death and hades (Revelation 1:18) assure us of our final release from death? From what and to what has he set us free (Revelation 1:5-6)?
