1. What in the sermon encouraged you, comforted you, challenged you, or informed you?
2. How does realizing we have a hidden and active enemy, Satan, prowling around like a lion to devour us demand that we be sober minded and alert? How might being sober-minded and alert affect the way we approach our daily planning, daily activities, and daily conflicts?
3. In what ways have you seen your pride breed skepticism about shepherd leaders over you or keep you from not drawing near to God?
4. How does humility before the Lord and submission to Christ enable us to resist the devil and his schemes? How might the awareness of the great power of the enemy and the greater power of our mighty hand of God humble us toward dependency in Christ?
5. Peter says that we resist our adversary Satan firm in the faith. This means claiming the promises of God of the supremacy of Christ over Satan and the security of Christ who has claimed victory over Satan. Read Colossians 2:13-15, Hebrews 2:14-15, Romans 16:20. What do these verses reveal about the supremacy of Christ and the victory of Christ over Satan?
