

**Sermon Discussion Questions: “Shelter in Place” (Psalm 16)**  
**March 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2020**

1. The first point of the sermon was that to find shelter in the Lord we must commit to Him alone. What are some practical ways that you can commit this time of social distancing to the Lord? What specific goals can you make to “set the LORD always before you” in Bible reading and prayer (Psalm 16:8)?
  
2. The second point of the sermon was that to find shelter in the Lord we must be content in Him alone. What is something that you have lost because of the Coronavirus scare and how has this made you feel? What are some personal idols that have been revealed through this time of hardship and how might you turn from them to the Lord?
  
3. In a time of loss how might we be content in the Lord alone? Can you remember another difficult time in your life that the Lord used for good?
  
4. The third point of the sermon was that to find shelter in the Lord we must be confident in Him alone. Where do you find yourself placing confidence in times of difficulty? How might we grow in our confidence in God’s Word?
  
5. The most important way that we have confidence in the Lord is through trusting in the life, death, and resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ. How does His resurrection give you comfort and hope in a time of fear?

Pray Psalm 16 together as a group letting the structure and phrases guide you along in prayer. Also consider reading these Psalms to prepare for next week:
