

FAQs ABOUT IN-PERSON SUNDAY WORSHIP AT ROCKLAND

IS THERE ANY PROGRAMMING FOR KIDS AND STUDENTS?

Nursery care (infants to 36 months) is available at the 9:30 and 11:00 AM services. Drop off starts 10 minutes prior to the start of the service, and we ask that you pick your child up promptly after the services so we can clean and sanitize in between services. Caregivers will be wearing masks, and parents must wear masks to drop off and pick up their children.

Sunday school is offered at our 9:30 and 11 am services for Preschool – 5th grade kids. Masks are worn by both leaders, staff and kids in 1st – 5th grade and sanitizing protocols are also followed in all Kids' classrooms (equipment and supplies are sanitized between classes).

The Middle School & High School are also meeting during the 11 am service in the youth room.

IS THERE A DOLLAR BILL PROGRAM?

Yes! Every dollar bill donated is matched by our outreach team and goes right out the door to our local or international mission partners! Bring your dollars and there will be an opportunity to drop them (along with your regular offering) in secure boxes as you enter or exit.

WHY ARE WE HAVING SIGN UPS IN ADVANCE?

In the event that we need to communicate about a COVID case from someone in attendance, we are using the signups from that specific service to email information out. It also helps us keep numbers reasonable for a safe worship experience.

WHAT ABOUT MASKS?

Masks are required to be worn through the entire 8am service. For the other services, masks can be removed once you are seated in a social distanced manner in the sanctuary.

WILL THERE BE COMMUNION?

We have volunteers who hand out individual, sealed communion packs as you enter the service if you would like to take it during the service.

WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING?

Bring a mask for each member in your party, and please bring a Bible!

HAS THE CHURCH BEEN CLEANED?

Absolutely! The church continues to be thoroughly cleaned. In addition, we are sanitizing the church every 30 days with anti-microbial misting, and we have a crew cleaning all the touchpoints (door-handles, etc.) before each service.
