

Hi, this is Pastor James and I am calling on behalf of the elders and deacons to let you know of some steps we are taking beginning this Sunday. Based on the information we received from the surveys that we have received and seeking to do what would be wise and best serve the needs of our church family, we have decided to have our regular service this Sunday (May 17) at 11:00 AM for our church family. We will be practicing distance seating (though we assume you will sit together as a family), we will provide masks and gloves for those that want to wear them. Because the sanctuary could have some limitations for seating, we are also providing an overflow in the youth room where the service will be livestreamed. That livestream will be available online beginning at 11:00 AM as well for those that choose to stay home.

For those that are not yet comfortable in a larger group setting, we are also providing a service at 8:30 AM. This service is limited to 50 people and we ask those that will be there to be wearing masks if medically possible. While no action is needed for the 11:00 service, we are asking that those interested in attending the 8:30 service to call the church office to reserve a spot by 4:30 PM tomorrow, Thursday, so we can keep the size of that service to 50. If our reservations exceed 50 after you call, we will call you back to let you know.

At this point, there will be no other ministry activities on Sunday. The changing room in the nursery will be open for parents as needed. If you are high risk with your health or if you or any of your family have been sick we would recommend that you stay home for the time being for the safety and health of others.

Though this is not yet ideal, we hope that this step will begin the process of gathering once again as a church. So, let us be considerate and patient toward one another in this process. If you have questions or need clarification on anything please contact an elder. We look forward to what the Lord has for us this coming Sunday.
