

## Responding To Person Revival

### Isaiah 6: 1-13

Take some time to read Isaiah chapters 1-5.

Read Isaiah 6:1-13 - summarize the story in your own words.

What are some inaccurate pictures of God that we hold?

Personal revival begins with an accurate revelation of God. When have you been confronted with the reality of God's surpassingly great holiness? How did you respond?

Spend time in verses 5-7. If holiness leads to humility, is there any pride lurking in your life that keeps you from seeing the holiness of God and experiencing personal revival? Spend time with the Father in honest and intimate evaluation.

Take a look at verses 8-10, where Isaiah receives his call and commission. It appears that verse 9 is what Isaiah is to tell the people and verse 10 is God's summary of what will happen. Describe what Isaiah's ministry will be like?

What would be some parallel situations of ministry today?

Look at verses 11-13. Isaiah's surprisingly cool response to this commission is to inquire how long he should continue. What is God's answer to this question?

What does this passage tell you about what it means to be called by God and the kind of response God requires? What is your response?
