

1 Thessalonians 5:11-12

- 11 Therefore encourage one another and build one another, just as you also are doing.
- 12 But we request of you, brethren, that you appreciate those who diligently labor among you, and have charge over you in the Lord and give you instruction,
- 13 and that you esteem them very highly in love because of their work.
Live in peace with one another.
- 14 We urge you, brethren, admonish the unruly, encourage the fainthearted, help the weak, be patient with everyone.
- 15 See that no one repays another with evil for evil, but always seek after that which is good for one another and for all people.
- 16 Rejoice always;
- 17 pray without ceasing,
- 18 in everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.
- 19 Do not quench the Spirit;
- 20 do not despise prophetic utterances.
- 21 But examine everything; hold fast to that which is good,
- 22 abstain from every form of evil.

Underlined words are commands to do (verb, present, active, imperative) *Pray is middle not active
