What If God Called You by Name?

When God was arranging the camp of the Israelites in Numbers 1-2, He called a few guys by name: Nahshon, Nethanel, Eliab, Elizur, Shelumiel, Eliasaph, Elishama, Gamaliel, Abidan, Ahiezer, Pagiel, Ahira. These men were to be the heads of the armies of the respective tribes of the Israelites, and God specified that these men were to be in charge. Little else is known of these men from the Bible (other than their tribes), but God knew them, and God called them out to serve, to lead, and to be examples.

Can you imagine having been Nahshon from the tribe of Judah? Moses calls you into his tent out of the blue and tells you that God has asked you to lead the armies of not only Judah, but also Issachar and Zebulun. What a huge responsibility! All of a sudden, you have been given charge of 186,400 men (and their families). And from another perspective, out of 186,400 men, YOU are the one whom God selected!

It is likely safe to assume that Nahshon was "somebody" among the tribe of Judah before God called him, but now he is "the man." Biblically, he would have three claims to fame: being named commander of Judah (Numbers 2:3); presenting the offering on behalf of Judah at the tabernacle's consecration (Numbers 7:12); and being in the genealogy of Jesus (Matthew 1:4). But he didn't ask for these things: God called him by name.

Many people enjoy anonymity. They enjoy being a "nobody," and have no desire to ask to become "somebody." Many—certainly not everyone, but many—would cringe if God were to call them by name. But just because Moses doesn't stand before the congregation and announce that YOU have been named by God to do this or that doesn't mean you are a "nobody."

Paul wrote in Philippians 4:3, "And I urge you also, true companion, help these women who labored with me in the gospel, with Clement also, and the rest of my fellow workers, whose names are in the Book of Life." Is your name in the Lamb's Book of Life? If so, who put it there? God did. God has known your heart, you desire for salvation, your obedience and submission to His gospel, and He has called you by name. You are "somebody" in Christ Jesus to God.

"But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;" (1 Peter 2:9)
