




¹The fool says in his heart, “There's no God.” They are corrupt; they do vile deeds. There is no one who does good.

²The LORD looks down from heaven on the human race to see if there is one who is wise, one who seeks God.




³All have turned away; all alike have become corrupt. There is no one who does good, not even one.

oppressed, but the LORD is his refuge.




⁷Oh, that Israel's deliverance would

let Jacob rejoice, let Israel be glad.



Reality of Our Sin








Reality of God's Grace
