⁶The point is this: The person who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and the person who sows generously will also reap generously. ⁷Each person should do as he has decided in his heart—not reluctantly or out of compulsion, since God loves a cheerful giver.

⁸And God is able to make every grace overflow to you, so that in every way, always having everything you need, you may excel in every good work. ⁹As it is written: He distributed freely; he gave to the poor; his righteousness endures forever.

¹⁰Now the one who provides seed for the sower and bread for food will also provide and multiply your seed and increase the harvest of your righteousness. ¹¹You will be enriched in every way for all generosity, which produces thanksgiving to God through us.


¹²For the ministry of this service is not only supplying the needs of the saints but is also overflowing in many expressions of thanks to God.







Give Cheerfully




Giving is important because it detaches us from the power of money and attaches us to the power our Provider.




***Generous giving helps us care less
