¹ Why do the nations rage and the peoples plot in vain?

² The kings of the earth take their stand, and the rulers conspire together against the LORD and his Anointed One:

³ "Let's tear off their chains and throw their ropes off of us."

⁴The one enthroned in heaven laughs;
the Lord ridicules them.

⁵Then he speaks to them in his anger
and terrifies them in his wrath:

⁶"I have installed my king on Zion, my
holy mountain."

He requires absolute loyalty.*



⁷I will declare the LORD's decree. He said to me, "You are my Son; today I have become your Father. ⁸Ask of me, and I will make the nations your inheritance and the ends of the earth your possession.

⁹You will break them with an iron scepter; you will shatter them like pottery."

¹⁰So now, kings, be wise; receive instruction, you judges of the earth.

¹¹Serve the LORD with reverential awe and rejoice with trembling.

¹²Pay homage to the Son or he will be angry and you will perish in your rebellion, for his anger may ignite at any moment. All who take refuge in him are happy.
