- Is anyone too "bad" to be saved and changed by God? Paul did some very bad things didn't he? Look up Acts 8:1-3. Does this sound like a man that God can save and use for His kingdom?

- So we see that what seems impossible for man is not impossible with God. He can soften even the hardest heart. He knows the plans He has for us. This is His grace. It is not something any of us deserve or can earn. Ephesians 2:8-10
- Read 1 Timothy 1:15-16. What is the trustworthy saying from Paul in verse 15? Do you see what God's purpose was in calling Paul?
- How can we glorify God and make Him known to others?
- Even during this quarantine, we can display God's goodness, and we can display the Gospel.
- Did you know that many of Paul's letters to the churches were written by him while he was in prison, and house arrest (for sharing the Gospel)? These letters that were inspired by God were not just for those churches, they are for us, too.
