Feb 6	Isaiah 41:10 So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.
Feb 13	Hebrews 13:6 So we say with confidence, "The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can man do to me?"
Feb 20	Psalm 27:13-14 I am still confident of this: I will see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living. Wait for the Lord; be strong and take heart and wait for the Lord.
Feb 27	Psalm 67:1-2 May God be gracious to us and bless us and make His face shine upon us, that your ways may be known on earth, your salvation among all nations.
Mar 6	Psalm 67:3-4 May the peoples praise you, O God; may all the peoples praise you. May the nations be glad and sing for joy, for you rule the peoples justly and guide the nations of the earth.
Mar 13	Psalm 67:5-6 May the peoples praise you, O God; may all the peoples praise you. Then the land will yield its harvest, and God, our God will bless us.
Mar 20	Psalm 67:7 God will bless us, and all the ends of the earth will fear him.
Mar 27	Ephesians 2:8-9 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast.
Apr 3	Ephesians 2:10 For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

Apr 10	1 John 5:11 And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son.
Apr 17	1 John 5:12 He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life.
Apr 24	1 John 5:13 I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life.
May 1	Romans 5:6-7 You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly. Very rarely will anyone die for a righteous man, through for a good man someone might possibly dare to die.
May 8	Romans 5:8 But God demonstrated his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
May 15	Ephesians 5:19-20 Speak to one another with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs. Sing and make music in your heart to the Lord, always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.
May 22	James 1:22 Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says.
May 29	James 1:23-24 Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is like a man who looks at his face in a mirror and, after looking at himself, goes away and immediately forgets what he looks like.
Jun 5	James 1:25 But the man who looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and continues to do this, not forgetting what he has heard, but doing it- he will be blessed in what he does.
Jun 12	1 John 4:7-8 Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God. Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love.
Jun 19	1 John 4:9-11 This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him. This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. Dear friends, since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another.
