Craft – Baby in a Manger

Today's craft is a little baby in a manger. We can look at this craft a remember from our story that Jesus, who is God, was born as a baby. He lived a human life, but unlike you and me, he lived it with never sinning, never being naughty or ever making God mad. Even though he lived like this, he followed God's plan to take all of the punishment for all the times we are naughty and sin and make God mad, so that we don't ever have to be punished by God.

For today's craft you will need a paper lunch bag, a piece of paper, some crayons, scissors, and a piece of toilet paper.

1. First you will need to help your little one cut along the fold at the bottom of your paper bag.



2. Next, cut the whole top part of the paper bag in thin strips. Open up the bottom part of the lunch bag and fill it with the strips.



3. Next, we will need to draw out a small "baby" for our little ones to cut out. It should be between two and three inches in length. Let your little one color on a face.



4. Lastly, wrap the baby in the toilet paper, and place him in the manger.
