Craft – Doves

Today's craft is a paper dove to remind us of Jesus's baptism by John the Baptist. When Jesus was baptized, we can remember from our story that God spoke, and said that Jesus was His Son, and that he loved him. He sent the Holy Spirit like a dove to fly to Jesus. We can know that God is so wonderful, He is God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit.

For today's craft you will need two pieces of white paper, crayons and scissors.

1. Fold a piece of paper in half, and draw the shape shown the best you can. 
2. Help your little one to cut out the shape, and then draw a little beak and an eye on both sides like shown. Then fold your little bird in half and cut a small slit about a half an inch down.
3. Place your second piece in front of you and make accordion folds like you would to make a fan. Fold the whole paper this way. Push this folded paper through the slit that you made in the bird.
4. Open up the wings, and you have a dove.
