Craft –Seeing Clearly!

When Jesus met Saul on the road to Damascus, he changed the way Saul saw the world. With the Holy Spirit, Saul now saw the world in a whole new way. Just like Saul we can see the world through the lenses that God gives to us. Let's make some fun glasses to remind us to view the world remembering that God is in control of everything.

All we will need for this week's craft is a piece of paper (any color), something to color with, maybe some stickers, scissors, and tape or a stapler.

- Start out by folding your piece of paper. On the crease draw the following images.
- Help your child to cut out the pieces of our glasses. Cut the ear piece in two so you have two ear pieces.
- Let your little one decorate the paper with crayons, markers, or even stickers.
- Tape the ear pieces to the eye piece and fold so you have glasses.
