## UKRAINE RELIEF

The situation in the Ukraine continues to decline. The war rages on, the daily headlines are tragic, and the images are difficult to see. Civilians seek shelter, the outflow of refugees has exceeded two million, and conflict continues. Despite all of this, I'm encouraged by believers who are holding fast to the hope of Christ. We would do well to remember that evil is real, but it is also limited. God's presence is never limited. So, while evil may be close by, our God is sovereign, and he is closer.

Here's one excerpt from a pastor in Ukraine:

*Hello friends, the day begins with everyone having to call and say "I'm alive." The phone does not go silent during the day, there is a lot of grief around ... Today is another similar day - food, help taking people to safety. Thank God the brave brothers arrived today, and we were able to take about 60 people to safety. They also helped our military with medicines and organized a center with medicines for civilians, in the same place you can get food. While I am writing these words outside the window of the explosions, I am afraid to go out into the city tomorrow because I will see the result of the shelling. In all these circumstances, Christ is more...*

### **So, how can we, as a church be involved when we are so far away from the conflict?**

We can **PRAY** – there are many ways to pray. There are prayer guides in the upper lobby to take and pray through. **Pray** for the people of Ukraine as the war progresses. Pray for safe passages out of war zones for the displaced. **Pray** for those involved in the war, especially those who do not know Christ as Savior. **Pray** for local churches, missionaries, and relief workers to care for the massive wave of refugees. **Pray** for government officials to lead with wisdom. **Pray** for Ukrainian believers as they seek to be a light in the darkness.

We can **GIVE** – We are partnering with the International Mission Board/Send Relief. Through Send Relief, IMB personnel and their local partners are actively ministering to Ukrainians escaping the escalating war. **100% of your gift** is used to provide emergency supplies, water, shelter, and clothing as the love of Christ is shown in practical ways.
