## SCRIPTURE READING

### Read: Philippians 2:9-11

“And I pray this: that your love will keep on growing in knowledge and every kind of discernment, so that you may approve the things that are superior and may be pure and blameless in the day of Christ, filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ to the glory and praise of God.”

## PRAYERS OF PETITION

**The following prayer prompts are a guide for you as you pray. Following each prompt, where it is appropriate, pray for specific names and situations that are part of your life. Call them this afternoon to check in on them or send them a card this week to let them know you're praying for them.**

Using Paul's prayer in Philippians 2:9-11 as a model of prayer, pray someone you know who is battling some physical sickness or ailment in the followings ways:

1. Pray for their physical healing and strength.
2. Pray for their love for God would grow in spiritual knowledge and discernment, to the glory and praise of God.
  - a. If they are not a Christian, pray that this would open their eyes to their spiritual need and for them to confess Christ as Lord.
  - b. If they are a Christian, pray that the Holy Spirit would strengthen them and sanctify them through this physical trial so their lives would display the glory and praise of God to those who are watching.
