WEEK 5 - INSPIRED COMMITMENT
November 22, 2015 / Genesis 25 & Hebrews 11

BIG IDEA: Abraham, by faith, put all He had into the vision God had given him. He was fully committed until his death. Abraham was committed to the vision because he longed for the greater fulfillment to which God's promises pointed. Staying committed to the vision was frequently hard. Abraham longed for the coming of God's kingdom. He was focused on and committed to, not the dust, but the glory of God.

Measuring a Life

Genesis 25:5-11

- Abraham was committed to the VISION.
- Abraham moved the vision forward through his OBEDIENCE.
- Our lives will be MEASURED by how we were part of God's vision.

A Life of Faith and Commitment

Hebrews 11:1-2; 8-12; 17-19

- Faith is the ASSURANCE of things hoped for and the CONVICTION of things unseen.
- Abraham and Sarah's faith is a STANDARD for each of us.
- Let your view of ETERNITY affect how you live today.

Stay Committed

Hebrews 12:1-2

- Live everyday in such a way that your eyes are always on the GOAL.
