#### **Deuteronomy 31, Joshua** Joshua – Called To Lead Israel

- Joshua experienced INTIMIDATION regarding the mission God had given him.
- The promise of God's presence provided Joshua with great COURAGE.
- The antidote to fear is a profound sense of the PRESENCE of God.
