

Wedding Vows

On your wedding day, the vows are the most important thing. Everything else is bonus.

"Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and they shall become one flesh" ~ Genesis 2:24

You may select any of the following sample vows, or you may write your own, borrowing phrases and ideas from the ones you like. Some of the key ideas that should be communicated in the wedding vows are a focus on God, your love and commitment to each other, and your dependence on God to glorify Him.

Vows can be presented in one of three ways:

- 1. Phrase by phrase prompting
- 2. Memorized
- 3. Read from a card

Traditional #1

Woman: I,, take you,, to be my wedded husband, to have and to hold from this day forward, for better, for worse, for richer, for poorer, in sickness and in health, to love, comfort, and obey you, honor and keep you in joy and in sorrow, and to preserve with you this bond, holy and unbroken until God by death shall separate us and thereto I give you my pledge. Where you go I will go, where you lodge I will lodge. Your people shall be my people and your God my God.

Man: ______, I love you as Christ loves us unconditionally, unselfishly and eternally. I receive you as my wife, my helpmate, a gift from God. Using God's Word as my guide, I promise to be the head, and spiritual leader of our home, to protect, respect, cherish and provide for you and our children. I commit myself to do these things, by the power of the Holy Spirit, for all of my life.

Woman: ______, I love you as Christ loves us, unconditionally, unselfishly and eternally. I receive you as my husband, my protector, a gift from God. I will submit to you as my head, and accept you as my spiritual leader. I promise to honor, respect, exhort and trust you, and to provide a loving and happy home, for you and our children. I commit myself to do these things, through the power of the Holy Spirit, for all of my life.
