# Exchanging rings is a tradition that symbolizes the promise of your vows.

You may select any of the following sample ring exchange vows, or you may write your own, borrowing phrases and ideas from the ones you like.

Vows can be presented in one of three ways:

- 1. Phrase by phrase prompting
- 2. Memorized
- 3. Read from a card
