For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures, 1 Corinthians 15:3–4 (ESV)

If Christ didn't rise from the dead, <u>would</u> it <u>change</u> <u>my</u> <u>faith</u>?

And if Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain and your faith is in vain. We are even found to be misrepresenting God, because we testified about God that he raised Christ, whom he did not raise if it is true that the dead are not raised. For if the dead are not raised, not even Christ has been raised. And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile and you are still in your sins. Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished. If in Christ we have hope in this life only, we are of all people most to be pitied. But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. 1 Corinthians 15:14–20 (ESV)

1. Christianity would be a waste of time.

2. The Bible would be an evil book.

1. Jesus is not just another dead religious teacher.

"Brothers, I may say to you with confidence about the patriarch David that he both died and was buried, and his tomb is with us to this day... he foresaw and spoke about the resurrection of the Christ, that he was not abandoned to Hades, nor did his flesh see corruption. This Jesus God raised up, and of that we all are witnesses. Acts 2:29, 31–32 (ESV)

Jesus said to him, "<u>I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me</u>. John 14:6 (ESV)

Now the works of the flesh are evident: sexual immorality, impurity, sensuality, idolatry, sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, fits of anger, rivalries, dissensions, divisions, envy, drunkenness, orgies, and things like these. I warn you, as I warned you before, that those who do such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. Galatians 5:19–21 (ESV)

2. There is forgiveness for my past.

And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and <u>books were opened</u>. Then another book was opened, which is the book of life. And the dead were judged by what was written in the books, according to what they had done. Revelation 20:12 (ESV)

And <u>if Christ has not been raised</u>, <u>your faith is futile and you are still in your sins</u>. 1 Corinthians 15:17 (ESV)

3. There is freedom from the <u>power</u> of <u>sin</u>.

but he whom God raised up did not see corruption. Let it be known to you therefore, brothers, that through this man forgiveness of sins is proclaimed to you, and by him everyone who believes is freed from everything from which you could not be freed by the law of Moses. Acts 13:37–39 (ESV)

If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who dwells in you. Romans 8:11 (ESV)
