- **Abortion- What is it and the aftermath**

The deliberate termination of human pregnancy has ended the life of over 45 million children in the United States since Roe v. Wade. Paola Sanchez will discuss the impact abortion has had on women, families, and the church and how the church must take a biblical approach to ministering to those affected.

- **Life Support**

Our human bodies are designed as a complex machine where many organs and systems constantly work to keep it healthy. There are some functions so critical that if they ceased to work you would not live. However, when they fail, there are special medical procedures and machines, commonly known as life support, can keep you alive until your body is able to take over again. Just like life support measures and machines, Pregnancy Resource Centers across America play a vital role in sustaining women and families who face unplanned pregnancy. Roxanne Cain will equip the church with the knowledge of women's resource centers services and look at all available options to choose life.

- **Biblical intimacy** and how to talk about it with our children
As image bearers of God, we are designed for relationship with Him and one another. With that comes the longing for intimacy and true fellowship. Patty Buckley will help us explore our identity in Christ and how that informs the way we think about sex and the way we talk about it with our children in a fallen world.

KEYNOTE SPEAKER:

Paola currently works as the Executive Director of Resources for Women, a Pregnancy Center located in Daytona Beach. Resources for Women opens its doors every day to men and women facing unplanned pregnancies; they receive counseling and education in all of their options and also a limited OB Ultrasound to verify the viability of their pregnancy; 85% of the Women that are considering abortion and go through our program decide to carry to term.

Paola was born in the United States and raised in Bolivia, South America where she was a youth leader.

She was leading her first group when she was 17 (2004) and didn't stop working as a youth leader until they moved back to America on 2017. They lived in New York for two years and felt the call of God to move to Florida to work at Resources for Women.

Paola and her husband Christian have been married for 9 years they have 2 children and currently live in DeLand, Florida.

Roxanne has worked in medical at a local hospital and has worked at the Health Department. After 30 years of employment she retired from secular work and became the first Center Director for Grace House Women's Center in Edgewater and currently serves as Center Director at the New Smyrna Beach location.
